

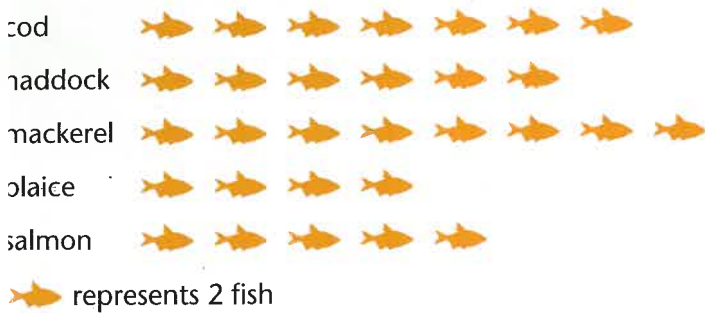
TARGET To present data in pictograms.
