Jo got a present and Jo liked the present.

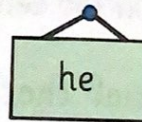
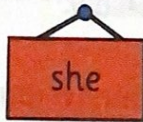
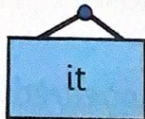
This is very repetitive.
