Maths

LO: To use addition to work out word problems.

First discuss the + symbol, see if your child can tell you what it means, if not discuss it means add or plus. This is when we add numbers together to get a total.

Using the worksheet uploaded on the website (there are separate year 1 and year 2 worksheets) please let your child have a go at reading the word problems or you and read them together and then write a number sentence to go with the word problem such as **10+4=**

Please can the child then have a go at working out the answer. It may be that your child can do this mentally and this is fine, they may wish to use the number line or number square to count on from a number (these are in their home learning packs.), alternatively you may wish to provide equipment such as dry pasta pieces, toy cars or even buttons for your children to use to add numbers together. Any of these strategies are fine to use each child will be different so what works for one child may not work for another.

English

LO: To write a setting description.

Discuss with your child the picture 'Safari' about what they can see using loads of describing words (these are called adjectives) in noun phrases such as 'cool, rippling water',

I would expect most of the Year 1 children to write at least 2 sentences and most of the Year 2 children to write a minimum of five sentences for this.

Please remind your child to remember their capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. I will be extremely impressed if they are able to use a conjunction (connecting word such as and, but, or) and some more interesting description words such as rippling, royal blue, enormous.

Topic

LO: To understand of visiting the dentist.

We have been looking at the importance of oral health in school prior to Christmas. As a follow on from this please discuss with your child what they know about the dentist. What do they do? Why is it important to go to the dentist?
