

LO: To understand the standard unit of measure for capacity.

Activity:

Now you know what capacity is, see if you can find 6 different containers you can find around your house and put them in order of which holds the most to the least amount of liquid.

Extension activity:

If you have a measuring jug at home and are able to measure the amount of liquid each of your containers hold then why not write a label next to each of the containers with the measurement on. You can then check if you put your containers in the right order of most to least amount amount of liquid.

Remember we measure capacity using:

millilitres = ml

litres = l

There are 1000 millilitres in 1 litre.

1l = 1000ml

1000ml = 1l
