

Maths – Week Commencing 11th January 2021

Monday	<p>LO: To understand the standard unit of measure for length.</p> <p>Watch the video on the class page of the website.</p> <p>Complete the worksheet – this can be completed in the squared workbook. There is additional information about the measurement of length on the worksheet.</p> <p>The items can be anything but I would recommend finding things that are easily measurable in cms using a ruler (if you have one).</p>
Tuesday	<p>LO: To be able to measure items using a standard unit of measure.</p> <p>Discuss what your child can remember about measuring length from yesterdays learning.</p> <p>Complete worksheet – this can be completed in maths workbook.</p>
Wednesday	<p>LO: To be able to order measurements from smallest to largest/ largest to smallest.</p> <p>Discuss with your child how many cms are in 1m as this will help with todays learning. Ensure that you stress your child to read the unit of measure which is after each number.</p> <p>Complete worksheet – this can be completed in maths workbook.</p>
Thursday	<p>LO: To use my addition and subtraction skills to answer word problems.</p> <p>This session is a recap to see what your child can remember. Quickly recap addition and subtraction.</p> <p>Ask your child to complete the word problems.</p>
Friday	<p>LO: To practise my 2 (Year 1) or 5 (Year 2) timestables.</p> <p>There are some ideas on how to help with timestables on todays home learning section on the class page of the school website.</p> <p>Your child is to complete as many of these questions as possible.</p>
