3. 6 elephants are splashing in the water. 11 more elephants join them. How many elephants are there altogether?
4. 9 lizards are sleeping in the sun. 2 of the lizards have stripy skin.  
How many lizards do not have stripy skin?
5. There are 15 lions. 3 of them have manes. How many do not have manes?
