### Addition and Subtraction Word Problems

3. In a tube of sweets, Kate finds 7 orange ones, 6 green ones and 3 yellow ones. How many sweets are there altogether?
4. Lily's mum has 28p in her purse. Lily has 11p. How much do they have altogether?
5. How much more does Lily's mum have than Lily?
6. The children in Mr Hornsey's class earned some extra minutes of playtime. Normally, they have 15 minutes. Now they have 21 minutes. How many extra minutes did they earn?
