



Term 6 in Robins Class

This term's focus topic is: 'Global Gardens'

Maths

This term we will be looking at and revisiting:

- Measurement (mass)
- Money
- Place value
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

English

Non-Fiction writing — Write about how plants grow, writing a fact file about Claude Monet. Write a setting description of a garden.

Write a letter to explain why it is important not to litter.

Within the above types of writing, we will be concentrating on developing and revisiting the use of capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and question marks as well as the use of a variety of conjunctions (connecting words such as and, because, but), noun phrases and use of adjectives. Additionally to this, we will be looking at the apostrophe s ('s) which is used to show possession of something - learning how to use an exclamation mark, as well as developing the use of conjunctions further.

Science

This term our topic is 'plants'. This will allow us to investigate the different parts of a plant, identify different types of plants and describe the basic structure of a plant.

Topic - 'Global Gardens'

This topic will give us the opportunity to look at how gardens are different around the world.

Art - we will look at a number of artists including Claude Monet, Andy Goldsworthy and Vincent Van Gogh.

Music - We will be looking at the topic of weather and how we can use our voices expressively and creatively to sing songs. We will also be playing tuned and untuned instruments.

Computing - In computing we will learning about animation and coding.

PSHE - We will be looking at keeping safe in the sun. We will also be looking at water safety.

RE - The children will be looking at the religion of Christianity and what Christians learn and understand about God and Jesus through the Bible.

Physical Education

This term we are going to focus on the skills needed in a range of sports through the topic fair, share, dare. We hope this will help to embed crucial values such as fairness and respect.
